# **Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020 (herein after "RRS").

# **Eligibility**

The regatta is open to all class legal Lasers with Standard, Radial or 4.7 rigs. The regatta is open to all ages. Skippers who are under 20 years of age as of 12/31/2018 will be considered juniors.

#### **ENTRY and REGISTRATION**

The entry fee is \$85.00 per entry. Late registration charge for this regatta is \$95.00. Late Registration is December 22, 2017 Complete the online entry form at **RegattaTech** or complete an entry form at check-in.

Check-in will be conducted on Saturday January 27 between 0800 and 0930 in the Corinthian Sailing Club's Club House. All Times are listed as Central Standard Time, CST. All sailors are required to check in by 0930 on Saturday at the registration table, even if the sailor pre-registered.

#### **SCHEDULE**

Subject to the decisions of the Race Committee, eight or more races are scheduled. One or more races will constitute a regatta. Unless modified by the Sailing Instructions or announced at the Competitor's Briefing and posted on the official notice board, the schedule will be as follows:

# **MEALS**

Meals for the competitors are included in the entry fee. Additional meal packages will be \$30.00 per person. Meals included in the entry fee or meal packages consist of breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday plus a breakfast and lunch on Sunday.

#### **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration and the mandatory Skippers Meeting. When Sailing Instructions are available they will be posted at <a href="https://www.cscsailing.org">www.cscsailing.org</a>

# TROPHIES/PRIZES

Event trophies will be awarded based on the number of entries.

#### **COURSES**

Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions. It will typically be a windward leeward with an offset.

#### **SCORING**

Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. The number of races will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

#### **RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

The Race Committee will use a VHF radio and will provide the Channel in the Sailing Instructions.

# **DIRECTIONS**

The Corinthian Sailing Club is located at 441 E. Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218.

#### **GENERAL and FACILITIES**

Boats can be stored overnight Saturday on the CSC docks on either Kitty-Hawk type trailers or dollies. While the facility is gated with code-only access, there is not a security guard on site and the Corinthian Sailing Club will not assume responsibility for property left on the premises. Foot protection is required while on CSC piers.

Corinthian Sailing Club is located within the Dallas Parks Department White Rock Lake Park. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the park, however alcoholic beverages are allowed within the gated portion of the Corinthian Sailing Club only. Restrooms, but no showers are available at the club. Camping is not available, but a wide choice of accommodations is available nearby. With advanced notice we may, on a limited basis, try to house sailors with club members. We may also be able to arrange loaner boats depending upon availability.
