

Sixth Annual Commodore's Cup Corinthian Sailing Club On White Rock Lake

Notice of Race

April 21 - 22, 2018

Event: The Corinthian Sailing Club (OA) cordially invites you to an open regatta for all centerboard boats and the Corinthian Class Keel Boat. The event is supporting the "White Rock Lake Conservancy".

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

Entry: Registration may be completed online at cscsailing.org. Late registration (after Saturday April 14) may be completed online or at the regatta site at 441 E Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218. Sailing Instructions will be available online and at check in.

Classes: Three boats of any one design will race as a class. Boats that do not form a one design class will be assigned to a Portsmouth handicap class.

Fees include one T-shirt, and for all competitors, Saturday breakfast, lunch, happy hour, dinner and Sunday breakfast and lunch. Extra meals and T-shirts may be purchased at registration.

Courses: Two or three courses may be used. On the larger double-handed course, 5 races will be scheduled. On the single-handed course, 7 or more races will be scheduled.

7:00 - 8:30 Breakfast.

9:00 Warning signal for the first race of the day.

No race will be started after 12:00 on Sunday. Lunch will be served. Awards presentation to follow.

Scoring: The low point scoring system, Appendix A of RRS will be used except no score will be excluded. One race constitutes a regatta.

Boat Storage: Temporary boat storage may be arranged by contacting Steve Benenson at race@cscsailing.org

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top 2 finishers in each class. If the class has 5 or more entries, the top 3 finishers will be awarded. In addition, each prize winner from each fleet will have their name and place of finish permanently inscribed on the Commodore's Cup Trophy, a perpetual trophy to be displayed in the Corinthian Sailing Club clubhouse on a permanent basis.
