## Notice of Race

October 6, 2018

**Event**: The Corinthian Sailing Club (OA) cordially invites you to a one-day, open regatta for all centerboard boats and the Corinthian Class Keel Boat. The regatta will also serve as the Special Olympics Texas State Championship Regatta.

**Rules**: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

**Entry**: Registration may be completed online at www.cscsailing.org. Late registration (after Sunday, September 30) may be completed online or at the regatta site at 441 E Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218. Special Olympics registration will be done through Special Olympics Texas. Sailing Instructions will be available at check in.

**Regatta Plan**: The State Fair Regatta is a one-day regatta with three to five races planned. Three or more boats will race as a class. Boats that do not form a one design class will be assigned to a Portsmouth handicap class. Special Olympics classes and divisioning will be determined per Special Olympics sailing rules.

Fees include for all competitors, breakfast, lunch, post-race snacks and refreshments. T-shirts are \$10 and may be purchased online by September 30<sup>th</sup>. For those not ordering t-shirts online by September 30<sup>th</sup>, you can still order them online after September 30th (as we will have extra shirts at the registration table) but we cannot guarantee they will be available in your size. Extra lunch tickets may also be purchased at registration.

<u>Courses</u>: Two courses will be used. One race constitutes a regatta. The courses to be sailed are those specified in the Corinthian Sailing Club Sunday Joint Race Program Sailing Instructions.

## Schedule:

8:30 – 9:30 Breakfast, check-in and late registration.

9:45 Skippers meeting.

10:30 Warning signal for the first race.

- One or two races are scheduled prior to lunch.
- Lunch break at the dock.
- Additional races will follow the lunch break.

Snacks and refreshments will be provided and awards will given at the clubhouse after the races.

**Scoring**: The low point scoring system, Appendix A of RRS will be used except no score will be excluded.

**<u>Prizes</u>**: Prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in each class, depending on the number of boats registered.

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
